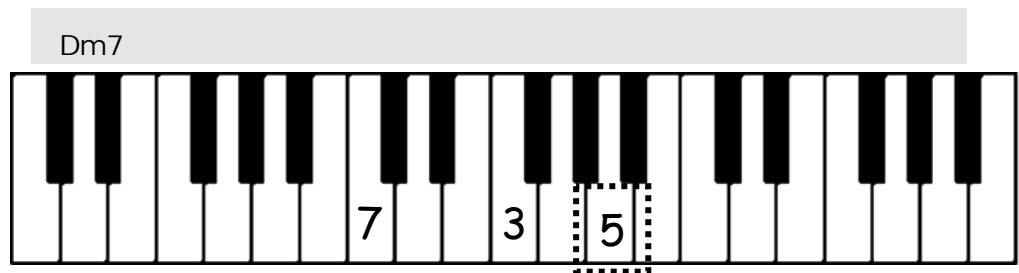


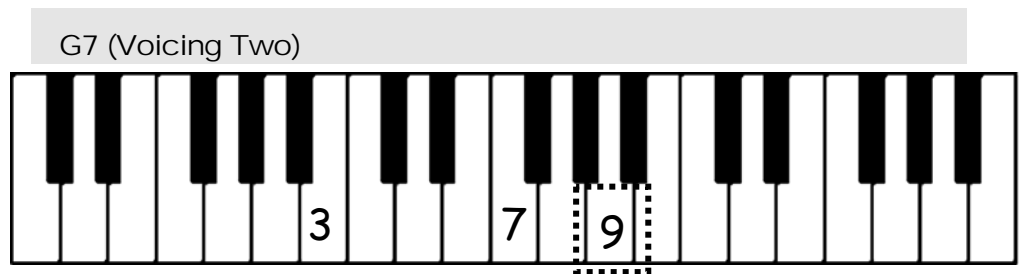
Thirteenth Chords

The sixth is the natural extension around the circle of fifths from the 5th and the 9th. If the fifth of a II chord becomes the 9th of a V chord, then that 9th note will become the sixth of the next chord.

For example, the note A is the fifth of Dm7



and the 9th of G7



and the 6th of a C6 chord.
