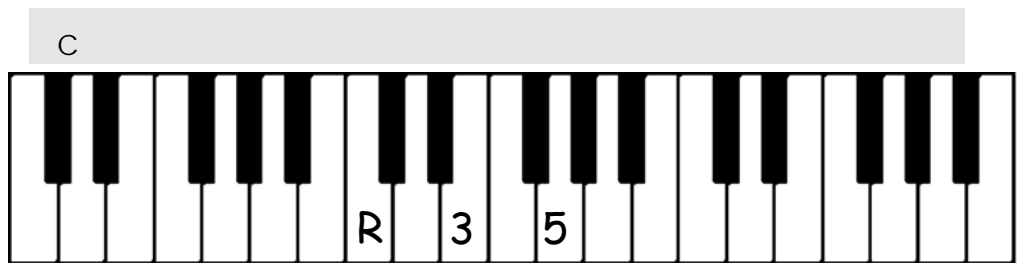


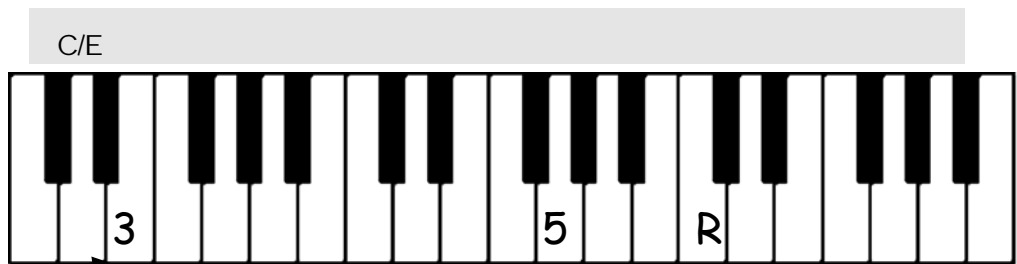
Chapter 7: Inversions

Inversion means simply that you change the order of the notes in a chord. The difference between an inversion and a voicing is just that an inversion has a different root.

If the Root is on the bottom of a chord, it is called **Root position**.

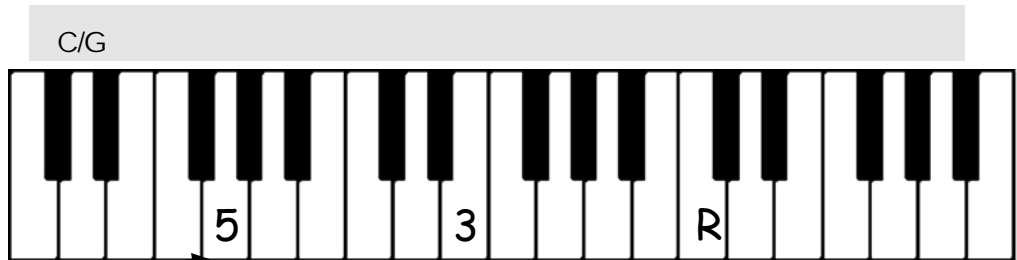


If the 3rd is on the bottom of a chord, it is called **first inversion**.
